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## Statement of Activities for 2014/2015

Parish Councils are required to provide Council Tax payers with details of their budgeted activities for the forthcoming financial year. The 2014/15 information for Radcliffe on Trent Parish Council is as follows.

The Council provides, manages and maintains a large number of facilities in the parish and it also owns the residential bungalow at Rockley Memorial Park. The properties are:

To manage these undertakings the Council employs 4 part-time Office Staff, 2 full-time Grounds Staff, a Caretaker for Grange Hall, The Grange and the Public Toilets, a part-time Cleaner and part-time Hall Duty Officers and Kitchen Helpers for events.

The popularity of our community buildings, The Grange and Grange Hall, continues. Bookings remain strong for the current and future years. Events include Civil Weddings, Christenings, Funeral Receptions and Birthday Parties, Concerts, Dances and Drama, Fitness Classes, Exhibitions and Training Seminars. There are regular bookings for a wide range of Educational Classes. Both venues offer Wi-fi facilities.

To finance Grange Hall in 2004 and the refurbishment of The Grange in 2009 the Council took Public Works Loans (PWL). The remaining loans will be repaid by equal capital instalments by 2029. Further early repayments are anticipated in the budget

During the year there was the opportunity to purchase the area of land alongside the River Trent, known as The Lily Ponds, for an inclusive amount of £34,097. A grant of £3,000 for maintenance has been received from the Canals and Rivers Trust

The budgeted Parish Precept is £84.62 per Band D property - a nil increase per property for the third successive year. There is an increase in the number of properties subject to precept (3,072 last year to 3,102 this year). The Transitional Grant introduced last year by Rushcliffe Borough Council has been reduced from £18,558 to £15,620. Next year is the final year of the Transition grant – it is to be £13,260

The anticipated free reserves for both 31 March 2014 and 2015 are £110,169
