Event Bulletin - Newark & Sherwood, and Rushcliffe Area

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES and RESTRICTIONS for **OUTLAW HALF TRIATHLON EVENT on SUNDAY 1st JUNE 2014**

- Prohibition of Driving (except pedal cycles and vehicles in connection with the event) 06:00 to 12:00 hours
 - (a) Hawksworth Road, (Scarrington) between its junctions with Car Lane, (Car Colston) and Main Street, (Scarrington)
 - (b) East Bridgford Road (Newton) whole length
 - (c) Moor Lane (Epperstone) between its junction with A6097 Oxton By Pass and a point 25 metres south of that
 - (d) Nottingham Road, Lowdham (Station Road to A612/A6097 section) between its junction with A612 Southwell Road and a point 5m southeast of that junction
- (2) One Way Traffic Restrictions (except local service buses, pedal cycles and vehicles in connection with the event) - 04:00 to 12:00 hours
 - (a) Nottingham Road (Radcliffe on Trent) proceed in a southwesterly only direction for a distance of 10 metres to its junction with A52 Grantham Road
- (3) One Way Traffic Restrictions 06:00 hours to 12:00 hours
 - (a) Kirk Hill (East Bridgford) proceed from North to South only for a distance of 25 metres to its junction with A6097 By Pass Road
- (4) Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Unloading 06:00 hours to 12:00 hours
 - (a) B6386 Westgate (Southwell), north side, between its junctions with Trinity Road and A612 Nottingham Road
 - (b) Shelford Road (Radcliffe on Trent), southeast side, between its junctions with Main Road and New Road
- (5) Prohibition of Right Turn 06:00 hours to 12:00 hours
 - (a) From A6097 Lowdham By Pass Northbound (Lowdham) into Ton Lane East
 - (b) From A6097 Lowdham By Pass Southbound (Lowdham) into Ton Lane West
- (6) Left Turn only 06:00 hours to 12:00 hours
 - (a) From Ton Lane East (Lowdham) into A6097 Lowdham By Pass Southbound
 - (b) From Ton Lane West (Lowdham) into A6097 Lowdham By Pass Northbound
 - (c) From Kirkhill, (East Bridgford) into A6097 By Pass Road, Southeastbound

Outlaw Half Triathlon - Sunday 1 June 2014 and Outlaw Triathon - Sunday 27 July 2014

On Sunday 1 June and Sunday 27 July 2014 One Step Beyond Promotions will be organising separate triathlon events, which will pass through your parish during the cycle section. These events will see over 1000 competitors taking up the challenge of a 1.2 mile Swim, followed by 56 mile Cycle before finishing 13.1mile Run for the Outlaw Half and 2.4 mile Swim, followed by a 112 mile Cycle before finishing with a 26.2 mile Run for the full event.

May we take the opportunity to thank everyone for the support shown to the athletes at our previous events and we hope to see people from the local community once again supporting the athletes in these mammoth challenges.

We have been working with local Councils and businesses to maximise the potential benefit to the local economy with spectators travelling from across the UK to support the athletes, whilst also ensuring that the event has minimal impact on local residents and is embraced again by local people.

These events will both be based at the National Water Sports Centre (Holme Pierrepont) Nottingham, with the swim and run sections taking place in the lake and along the riverside path respectively. The cycle section for both events will travel through the beautiful Nottinghamshire Countryside using routes that will pass along the A52, through Radcliffe on Trent.

Depending upon which event the cyclist is undertaking they will either head over the new A46 completing an eastern loop around Car Colston, Hawksworth, Shelton, Elston, Farndon, Hawton and then heading north to Lowdham, Oxton, Southwell, Kirklington, Farnsfield before returning via Lowdham to repeat the eastern loop, before returning to the National Water Sports Centre for the Outlaw Triathlon.

For the Outlaw Half, the cyclists will start using the same route towards East Bridgford, before heading north towards Gunthorpe, Lowdham, Oxton & Southwell. From Southwell, the cyclists return towards Oxton and then head south to East Bridgford and Car Colston. The cyclists then do a short loop, including Hawksworth, Flawborough, Alverton, Orston & Scarrington. The cyclists will then head back through Radcliffe on Trent, before cutting through Holme Pierrepont Hall.

We have been working closely with Nottinghamshire County Council Highways department for over 12 months to ensure that we get a balance between providing a safe route for the athletes and making sure the impact on other road users is kept to a minimum. Attached are copies of the confirmed routes, we would like to work closely with you to ensure that everyone understands the routes and where roads are closed what will be the easiest diversion on the day.
