1. Apologies

Cllr Joe Bailey - approved.

2. <u>Declarations of Interest</u>

3. Minutes of the Previous Meeting Held on 04 April 2016

It was: **Resolved**: "That the minutes of the meeting are approved as an accurate record and were signed by the Chairman."

4. Chairman's Announcements

At the Annual Parish Meeting the Chairman reported a number of people raised the issue of road safety and lack of crossings on Shelford Road. Cllr Culshaw has concerns as there was also 2 serious accidents last year. Cllr Cutts is dealing with this issue and is taking things forward. It now looks likely there will be a zebra crossing at the bottom of Shelford Road to be paid for out of the coming budget.

The Chair attended the Stakeholder Poacher Line meeting last week. An NCC Officer indicated that they were looking at the possibility of a refuge crossing in the vicinity of Grandfield Avenue. This needs to be followed up by re-writing to NCC asking for details specifically about Grandfield Avenue. Also we need to confirm if and when there will be a Working Group set up to discuss the Shelford Road Crossings and the crossing on the A52 near to Saxondale. A Highway's Officer should then be invited to a Planning Meeting before summer to speak specifically about our issues and concerns.

5. Clerk's Report on Previous Minutes

M. (5) Four Year Plan Phasing and Priorities

Pedestrian Access through hedge between Health Centre & Royal Oak Car Park: Ongoing. Cllr Agar has spoken to a representative at Enterprise Inns, and will be seeing him again next week for the contact details of the Area Manager.

6. M.16 Roadworks Updates

The Clerk has spoken with Trent Barton to clarify the effect on the bus services whilst the roadworks are in progress: The Villager 1 will run as normal on Shelford Road, Mainline will go along the A52, Cropwell Road Junction (at the top). Stops to be confirmed, Bingham night time service will not be affected, but a couple of stops may be changed. At the previous Planning Meeting a point was raised in the open public session whereby a shuttle bus was requested, however this will not be provided or paid for by Trent Barton.

7. Open Session for Members of the Public to Raise Relevant Matters

- 8. Standing orders were suspended at 7.13pm
 - Cllr Upton discussed the issues of pedestrian crossings and confirmed he had been in recent contact with Paul
 Hillier at NCC Highways Dept. The Highways Department has been asked to do speed checks on Shelford Road,
 and have accident statistics freely available. It is agreed that Wakefield Avenue and Queens Road is a good place
 to carry out the checks. Cllr Upton is optimistic the speed checks will go ahead on Shelford Road, and also
 confirmed Cllr Cutts is working with the NCC Highways on this issue.
 - Cllr Upton refers to the Cedar Lodge planning application and comments that he can see difficulties with condition 1
 and 5, he will be interested to hear any conclusions that are reached.
 - A member of the public states that the Health Centre Car Parking remains confusing, as the current parking order covers the maximum amount of flexibility. He is concerned that it would be a backward step if any future orders are made without public consultation.
 - A member of the public makes reference to 13 (b) of the agenda, (Pedestrian Crossings Requests) and asks for a
 Working Group to be formed, with Highways Department input. A site visit should be arranged, as it is not
 appreciated by NCC the problems the blind currently face when crossing the roads.
 - Clir Agar asks if it would be possible for a member of the blind community to be co-operated onto the Working Group. This will be considered after initial meetings.

Cllr Thompson provided an update. The Working Group met with Michael Webb from East Midland Trains and John McQuarrie from the Department of Transport on the 6th April 16. It was agreed that some calls (train stops) could be made without affecting train timetables, however the aspiration is for an hourly service for Radcliffe. Cllr Culshaw has spoken with Jayne Wingad who deals with the Poacher Line, and she has asked the Group to prepare a Business Case over the next two months for a better service. Cllr Culshaw will make sure this is done.
