

Schools, community groups and interested individuals have the chance to visit the Materials Recovery Facility (MRF) in Mansfield, to see first-hand what happens to the items they put in their home recycling bins.

The visit will include an informative session using a range of methods such as short film, practical activities and where possible, a visit around the working site.

On special occasions there are also creative sessions to further understanding of the 3 R's - Reduce, Reuse and Recycle.

- The visits are open to Nottinghamshire schools and community groups and the information given relates to recycling in the boroughs and districts of Nottinghamshire (excluding Nottingham City).
- Visitors must be aged 7 or above.
- The working site is only accessible by an outdoor gridded metal staircase and consequently it is not suitable for wheelchair users or visitors with mobility difficulties.
- Hard hats, high visibility vests and audio headsets will be provided for visitors on the tours.
- Visits are usually held on a weekday morning or afternoon but evening visits can be arranged if required.
