I am writing to let you know about the overnight road closures for next week and the rest of this week. They will take place between 8pm and 6am.

Friday, 1 September

The A52 Eastbound and Cropwell Road North will be closed - see table C.

Saturday, 2 September

The A52 Westbound and Cropwell Road South will be closed – see table B.

Sunday, 3 September

The A52 Westbound and Cropwell Road South will be closed – see table B.

Monday, 4 September

The A52 Westbound and Cropwell Road South will be closed – see table B.

Tuesday, 5 September

The A52 Westbound and Cropwell Road South will be closed – see table B.

Wednesday, 6 September

The A52 Eastbound and Cropwell Road North will be closed - see table C.

Thursday, 7 September

The A52 Eastbound and Cropwell Road North will be closed – see table C.

Friday, 8 September

The A52 Westbound and Cropwell Road South will be closed – see table B.

On Monday 11th September, the Cropwell Road Junction will undergo commissioning, this will involve testing and sequencing of the traffic signals, street lights and pedestrian crossing points. The commissioning will take place during the day with a view to fully opening up the junction; i.e. the right turn ban will be lifted and traffic will be able to travel straight over the junction along Cropwell Road; in the afternoon. Once the junction is open, all daytime traffic management will be removed from site and all lanes will be available for the road user.

Following the commissioning, there may be a need to conduct finishing works, inspections and snagging works. We will endeavour to complete these works during the day without the need for traffic management, however some of these works may require lane closures at night to ensure the safety of our workers and the travelling public.

Pedestrian access to Radcliffe across the A52 will be maintained at all times.
