Radcliffe on Trent Parish Council invites you to join the **Great British Spring Clean** over the weekend of 3rd & 4th March 2018.

Saturday 3rd March 2018 from 10am to 12 noon, meet at the Grange.

• Litter-picking in the streets and areas through the village of Radcliffe. All equipment, including bags, gloves and litter picking sticks will be provided at the Grange.

Sunday 4th March 2018 from 10am to 12 noon, meet at the Rockley Park Pavilion.

• A big litter-pick along the river bank and around the Lily Ponds. Meet by the Pavilion in Rockley Park, where bags and litter picking sticks will be provided. Please wear appropriate clothing and stout footwear, e.g. boots or wellies. Gardening gloves would also be very useful.

DO TELL US IF YOU ARE HELPING

- Register your group by responding to this e-mail.
- Individuals come and join the Litter Pick events.
- Inform us of an area in our community that you wish to clean up.
- The Parish Council will have a list of areas/streets for cleaning.

HEALTH & SAFETY

- Gloves will be provided or you may wish to wear your own.
- Cover any cuts with surgical tape.
- Avoid rubbing mouth and eyes whilst working.
- Wash hands and forearms well after the Litter Pick and before eating or drinking.
- Beware of unidentified cans or canisters, oil drums, insecticides, broken glass etc.
- Discourage heavy lifting note the location and report it back to the Parish Council organiser.

DANGEROUS or POLLUTING ITEMS

- Note the location and report finding back to the Parish Council organiser.
- **DO NOT ATTEMPT TO MOVE SYRINGES OR HAZARDOUS WASTE**, note the location and report back to the Parish Council organiser.

WORKING WITH CHILDREN

- All children must be accompanied by a responsible adult when taking part in either event.
- Warn any children in your group not to pick up any items of which they are unsure.
- May we suggest that the schools have a litter-picking session in the own school area or field.
