We are an informal group of mainly Radcliffe residents, who work on a voluntary basis helping to maintain local green spaces - the riverside area and Lily Ponds as well as Dewberry Hill.

We hold monthly work sessions, generally on the first Sunday morning of each month.

Activities typically include maintenance of pathways to facilitate access both for walkers and anglers, pruning back brambles, litter clearance and control of invasive non-native Himalayan Balsam. We are also engaged in amphibian and wildlife survey work.

We provide most tools, there is no membership fee and all are welcome to join in.
