Rushcliffe Borough Council is seeking the views of resident, businesses and parking bay users on the following proposals:-

- **To restrict public parking in the Walkers Yard car park to 3 hours**
- **To restrict public parking in the Health Centre car park to 3 hours**
- **To introduce a drop-off zone within the Health Centre car park with a maximum waiting time of 15 minutes**

Off-street parking places (car parks) are provided by the Council in order to: assist traffic management by reducing the demand for on-street parking places; help meet the needs of people with disabilities; promote the economic vitality of town centres within the Borough; enhance access to civil, leisure and commercial facilities within the Borough; and to help protect the environment.

The Council is considering parking place changes for the following reasons:

- a. To maintain high-quality public off-street parking facilities.
- b. To encourage turnover by favouring short-stay parking to improve space availability for town centre visitors encouraging growth and maintaining town centre viability
- c. To recognise the need for limited regular short-stay parking for specified groups of users.
- d. To address the issue of congestion/high occupancy levels caused by all-day parking in off-street parking facilities in the Borough.
- f. To ensure compliance with legislative requirement.
