East Midlands Trains: Report from Working Group

- **15.** Cllr Pam Thompson provided the following update:
 - The requests to improve the services at Radcliffe were not included in the recently awarded franchise operations.
 However it was noted that this was in response to a second letter and the first was sent months ago and is believed to have been within the consultation period.
 - A meeting has been arranged on 21 October with Jim Bamford of the Notts Community Rail Partnership and Jayne Wingad of East Midlands Trains. John Macquarrie, Lead Negotiator at the Department for Transport will then be invited to attend a meeting with representatives from the Parish Council, the Trains Working Group, County / Borough Councillors and the Rt Hon K. Clarke MP.
 - A survey will be conducted on Monday/Wednesday/Friday next week and a petition is also in hand. A large campaign is needed
 - A resident hopes to take forward the Community Station Adoption Scheme

Neighbourhood Plan

a) Update and Minutes of Meeting 24 September 2015

16. It was noted that Full Council received a full briefing from the Neighbourhood Plan Chairman on 01 October. The Plan is progressing well and the public consultation is due to take place on 08 October. Members thanked Cllr Upton for his leadership and hard work on the project.

Severn Trent Water

18. No further correspondence has been received regarding investigations into the Bingham Road drainage system or any other parts of the village. The Clerk would remind the S.T Technician that they did promise regular reports.

New Bus Service

19. a) Rushcliffe Mainline, Villager and Nottsbus Connect Information

Members received notification from Nottinghamshire County outlining the rationale of the new bus services which came into effect on 30 August 2015. The service on Shelford Road is not satisfactory being reduced from two per hour. This has raised concerns regarding residents with walking difficulties and social isolation.

There are also issues with the village stops, as the buses now come direct from Bingham they are already full and cannot cope with the additional passengers at Radcliffe.

Resolved: "The Clerk to write a letter to Trent Barton advising that the Parish Council has tremendous concerns about the 50% reduction in the service on Shelford Road which effects the less mobile residents and could this be reconsidered when the timetabling is next reviewed. In addition, can Trent Barton ensure that at peak times the bus capacity is sufficient to meet demand."

A resident expressed concerns regarding the reduced service on Shelford Road. The Clerk would copy the resident into the letter to Trent Barton.
