

Radcliffe-on-Trent Parish Council

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Statement of Activities for 2017/18

Parish Councils are required to provide Council Tax payers with details of their budgets. The 2017/18 information for Radcliffe-on-Trent Parish Council is as follows.

The budgeted expenditure for 2017/18 is £381,582 which is funded by the parish precept of £281,279 and budgeted income of £100,303.

The Council submitted an Option To Tax Grange Hall with effect from 1 February 2017. A new rate chart for hiring the hall came into operation at that date including the VAT. Amended discount eligibility criteria were established giving discount to organizations/groups that operate for the benefit of the Parish and/or parishioners.

The Council presents its financial information by committee and the budgeted income, expenditure and net budget for the forthcoming year are shown in the following table:
