At the Parish Council meeting on 4th September, it was resolved to submit an

application to the National Association of Local Councils for the award of Quality Status.

The new Local Council Award Scheme has been designed to celebrate the successes of the very best local councils, and to provide a framework to support all local councils to improve and develop to meet their full potential. The scheme offers councils the opportunity to show that they meet the standards set by the sector, assessed by their peers, and to put in place the conditions for continued improvement.

#### Department for Transport - East Midlands Rail Franchise

The public consultation document sets out proposals to improve the train services on the East Midlands rail network. Soon a new contract will be let for the right to run the East Midlands services and as part of that the DfT are running a consultation.

Please read the consultation document all the way through and then, in the response form, give answers to the questions.
