A52 Nottingham Junctions - Overnight works

I am writing to let you know about work that will be carried out over the next two weeks in the vicinity of Radcliffe-on-Trent.

Starting on Monday 13 November and lasting for 8 weekday nights, there will be a series of lane restrictions on the A52, from the Nottingham Road junction through to the Bingham Road junction, to carry out a full drainage survey, in preparation for future works to improve the footpath for pedestrians. The restrictions will involve two way traffic lights on the A52 over a set length of the road, which will move along the A52 night by night as the survey works are completed.

To minimize future disruption, we will also take the opportunity to carry out some additional works at Nottingham Road and Cropwell Road junctions. We will be adding some shields to the new street lights to remove the amount of light reflected into homes, starting environmental planting works to replace vegetation removed as part of the works, and completing works to prepare for the installation of information boards at the eastbound bus stop.

This work will involve lane restrictions and temporary traffic lights around the Nottingham Road junction overnight on Monday 13 and Tuesday 14 November. All traffic movements will be possible throughout both nights, with the exception of the U turn and right turn from the A52 into Nottingham Road. The temporary traffic lights will move to the Cropwell Road junction overnight on Wednesday 15 and Thursday 16 November to complete this work
