Improve the facilities at Grange Hall by installing a new boiler and hot water heating system	Funded at cost of £24,000 from Parish Council reserves and net budget underspend in 2016/17. Work completed in May 2017
Carry out a renovation and refurbishment of the Rockley Memorial Park	£10,000 funded from the Amenities Committee's budget over 2016/18.
Present a series of Parish Council sponsored events	Funded by the Events budget of and Severn Trent's Community Events Fund.
Present regular Silver Screen and Children's film shows at Grange Hall.	Monthly Silver Screen
Organise a Christmas concert	Film showings, with Children's in the school holidays.
Hold a Village Show	2017 Show held on 3rd September
Lay on a Children's Fun Day in the summer holidays	2017 Fun Day held on 10th August
Organise a Picnic in the Park at Rockley Memorial Park	First event held on 25th June
Commemoration event on the 90th anniversary of the opening of the Memorial Park.	Events held at the Park and at Grange Hall on 15th October
Display Christmas lights with a switching on ceremony.	Plans in place for Sunday 26th November
Support a music festival for young people in the village.	First RADFEST held on Wharf Lane Ecreation Ground on 15th July
Carry out a referendum on the village Neighbourhood Plan .	Referendum held on 19th October. 91% Yes vote and Plan was therefore adopted.

Pursue the implementation of the Village Centre Economic Masterplan.	Adopted by the Parish Council and the Bingham and Radcliffe Economic Growth Board in July 2017
Represent village residents by giving our views on planning applications	Planning Committee meetings open to the public every six weeks
Maintain the pressure for improved public transport services for the village.	Lobbying of East Midlands Trains for better rail service and submission to rail franchise consultation
Seek funding for a new skatepark for the village.	Funding application submitted to the Borough Council in conjunction with the Users Group. Further applications being prepared
Seek planning permission for a Leisure Hub at Wharf Lane.	Discussions with partners
Give financial and logistical support to village groups and projects.	Support given to a range of groups. £5000 in Budget for grants.
