Notification of essential work on the A46 between the Hobby Horse Roundabout and Widmerpool

I am writing to let you know that we will be carrying out essential maintenance work on the A46 between the Hobby Horse roundabout and Widmerpool.

Work taking place during this scheme will include ditch clearance, filter drain remediation and repairs to the piped drainage system. Sections of the carriageway will be resurfaced, road markings refreshed, and signs replaced.

When will the work take place?

We will start the work on **19 February** and expect to complete it by **3 August**.

Please note that all planned roadworks are subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances. We will do our very best to complete the work as quickly as possible, keeping disturbances and noise to a minimum.

How will the work affect traffic?

To maintain a safe environment for our workforce and customers, we will need to use a mixture of closures. To reduce disruption we will carry out as much of the work as we can using single lane closures, which will be removed during busy periods. We will also need to close individual slip roads occasionally.

During resurfacing operations, full road closures will be required. This work is programmed to start on 23 April for 4 weeks. It will be carried out overnight, between approximately 20:00 and 06:00.

For full road closures we will put in place fully signed diversion routes, which have been agreed with the Local Authority. Access to properties within the works will be maintained.
