Dear Customer,

A52 NOTTINGHAM JUNCTIONS NIGHTTIME WORKS

We are writing to let you know that Highways England will shortly be carrying out some remedial works at the Cropwell Road and Nottingham Road junctions along the A52 in Radcliffe-on-Trent. We have identified broken surfacing at these two junctions. We recognise the impact that this is having on our customers and we are working with our contractors to get it repaired promptly to ensure that the road is safe for all road users.

The condition of the surfacing on this stretch of road falls below the standard of durability that we would normally expect. The remedial works are required due to what appears to be premature material failure. The cause of the failure is unclear, but our contractor has advised us that it may have been caused by unfavourable weather when the work was done. The extremely cold winter experienced earlier this year may also be a contributing factor.

I would like to apologise in advance for any inconvenience or disruption you may experience during this work. We'll make every effort to carefully manage noise levels to minimise the impact of our work on local residents.

When will this work take place?

We are working with our contractors to get the road repaired and have scheduled 28, 29, 30 and 31 August for this work to be done. A full closure is required between the junction of the A52 and A6011 to the junction of the A52 and A46, between 8pm and 6am when the road is quieter, on the above dates in August. During the day we will keep the carriageway open as usual.

We currently plan to close the westbound carriageway on 28 August and the eastbound on 29, 30 and 31 August.



Please note that the precise dates and times of the works may be subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances. Where possible, we'll keep you updated of significant changes.

How will it affect traffic?

We will be able to keep the junctions open during the remedial work; however, the following turning movements will be restricted at Cropwell Road Junction.

- Traffic heading North on Cropwell road will not be able to turn left (heading towards Nottingham)
- Traffic heading South on Cropwell road will not be able to turn Right (heading towards Nottingham)
- Traffic approaching from the A52 east will be able to turn left or right into Cropwell road

During the closure, we'll put in place fully signed diversion routes, which are noted below. You can also view details of the work on our website at https://highwaysengland.co.uk/regions/eastmidlands/?postcode=&keywords=&roads=&status or www.roadworks.org.

What are the diversion routes?

For traffic travelling eastbound from Gamston and Wheatcroft roundabouts:

For the A52 eastbound traffic, the diversion will be signposted from Gamston and Wheatcroft roundabouts diverting the traffic via the A606 southbound and then A46 northbound where it may re-join the A52.

For traffic travelling westbound from Saxondale roundabout:

For the A52 westbound traffic, the diversion will be signposted from Saxondale roundabout diverting the traffic via the A46 southbound and then A606 northbound where it may re-join the A52.

For local traffic travelling on A52 eastbound:

For local traffic travelling on A52 eastbound, the diversion is via Stragglethorpe Road southbound and then A46 northbound where it may re-join the A52.

For local traffic travelling A52 westbound:

For local traffic travelling A52 westbound, the diversion is via A46 southbound and then Stragglethorpe Road where it may rejoin the A52.



Strategic Traffic Diversions: for High Loads over 14'6" (4.4m)

Due to low bridge on the strategic route vehicles over 14'6 (4.4m) will follow:

For eastbound traffic, the diversion will be signposted from Gamston roundabout, diverting the high vehicles via the A6011 westbound to A612 northbound to A6097 southbound and then A46 southbound to A52 Saxondale roundabout where it may rejoin the A52.

For the westbound traffic, the diversion will be signposted from Saxondale roundabout diverting the traffic via the A46 northbound to A6097 northbound, A612 southbound and then A6011 westbound to A52 Gamston roundabout where it may re-join the A52.

Pedestrians and cyclists will be unaffected.

We have liaised with local bus companies, and they will be putting arrangements in place to ensure that passengers' journeys are not disrupted.

If you know of anyone else who may be interested in this information please pass it on.

Everyone's journey is different, and we advise that you plan your journey ahead of time and allow extra time to reach your destination via the prescribed diversion routes.



The diversion for the A52 Nottingham Local Diversion is as follows:

For Radcliffe on Trent:

- Eastbound leave the A52 at Nottingham Road Junction
- Westbound leave the A52 at Bingham Road Junction

Other local routes:

- Eastbound Follow Stragglethorpe Road to Stragglethorpe junction
- Take the slip road onto the A46 and follow to Saxondale Junction and take the exit slip road
- Westbound Enter the A46 via the on slip at Saxondale Junction and follow the A46 to Stragglethorpe junction
- Exit the A46 at Stragglethorpe junction and take the 3rd exit onto Stragglethorpe Road

Pedestrian access across the A52 shall be maintained at all times
