



RECYCLING TIPS

- A Tetrapak is a very complex material & would be rejected as a contaminate if placed in the blue wheelie bin.
- Put Tetrapaks in the new bins in the Health Centre Car Park and NOT in blue bins.
- Never put soiled nappies in the blue bins as they cannot be recycled: put them in the grey bin.
- Aluminium screw tops to wine bottles should be left on. They are melted with the glass bottles and the molten aluminium is taken off and made into ingots.
- Plastic Bottle Tops to Milk Cartons etc. should be removed and put in the grey bin for incineration. If left on, they bulk out the bottles, so carrying a lot of air they come off at the recycling plant and clog up the machinery.
