Statement of Activities for 2019/20

Parish Councils are required to provide Council Tax payers with details of their budgets. The 2019/20 information for Radcliffe on Trent Parish Council is as follows.

The budgeted expenditure for 2019/20 is £388,086 which is funded by the parish precept of £300,118 and budgeted income of £87,968. The Band D precept remains at £93.62 per annum.

The Council presents its financial information by committee and the budgeted income, expenditure and net budget for the forthcoming year are shown in the table below. The Council has approved an amended meeting and committee structure with Amenities and Grange and Grange Hall now being one Committee. Full council and Finance and General Purposes remain separate committees but hold their meetings on the same night. Planning remains unaltered.
