1. Apologies for Absence

2. Declarations of Interest  
There were no declarations of interest.
3. Chairman's Announcements  
The Chairman noted that there are no Radcliffe on Trent planning matters on the RBC Planning Agenda for Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> August.
4. Minutes of the Previous meeting held on the 01 July 2019 for approval

11. Trains Working Group Update

13. Correspondence  
RBC Tree Preservation Orders Not Required at 7 Berkley Crescent (2 Limes, 3 Maples) and 16 Westminster Drive (Goat Willow)  
Some Cllrs understood that ALL trees at Upper Saxondale were covered by Tree Preservation Orders however the Clerk confirmed there are some areas of Upper Saxondale not covered including 7 Berkley Crescent and 16 Westminster Drive. It was suggested that some trees may also be covered by other covenants.
14. A52 Nottingham Junctions Public Information Event  
Highways England have notified the PC of a VIP launch event date at Silverdale Community Centre on Friday 30<sup>th</sup> August, 10am until 12pm to share proposals for improvements to four junctions along the A52 at Silverdale, Gamston, Stragglethorpe Road and Bingham Road junctions as part of the wider A52 Nottingham Junctions Scheme. There will then be Public Information Events held at The British Legion in Radcliffe on Saturday 31<sup>st</sup> August, 10am until 4pm and at Morrisons in Gamston on Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> September, 10am until 4pm. Cllr Upton encouraged residents to attend the Public Information Event at The British Legion on the 31<sup>st</sup> August to find out if Carter Avenue will be affected and a copy of this information will also be uploaded onto the ROTPC website.
