Cotgrave Greenway – Remedial & Surfacing Works, October 2019

The Greenway has been open to public use since the formal opening in Spring 2019. The route has proved to be a popular and well used amenity.

Since completion, there has been some settlement in the access ramp off Holme Lane. This is not unusual given the ground conditions of the slope and so it was monitored since construction. Remedial work to this has been on hold to allow the peak period of use over the summer to elapse and to allow time for monitoring of the movement. The final surface dressing of the path up the ramps has also been held pending resolution of this issue.

Remedial works are now planned to be completed within the next 3 weeks, which will address this issue. The works will be undertaken at nil additional cost but will necessitate the temporary closure of the access ramp and sections of the route for up to a week. The remedial works are planned to be undertaken commencing 7th October.

Notices will be posted on site to give members of the public warning of the disruption.

Away from the ramp Via has been working with officers of Nottinghamshire County Council Green Spaces team and providing resources so that members of Cotgrave Country Park Friends are enabled to undertake management activities to the habitat and monitoring of protected species along the greenway. This will hopefully ensure boost the maintenance of the site is maintained and help the project achieve the biodiversity benefits originally envisaged.
