A52 Gamston roundabout to Wheatcroft roundabout

Update Bulletin 2 – 19.11.2019

Since my last bulletin on 29 October 2019, we have continued installing the new street lighting ducts, inspection chambers and foundations for the lighting columns in the verges next to the carriageway. This work will continue over the next few weeks.

Our Ground Control units have completed clearing residual overhanging vegetation in the area. The team will return at the end of our scheme to make sure there is no overhanging vegetation blocking light onto the carriageway from the newly installed LED lighting.

We have also completed surfacing works to the carriageway as well as white line renewal to the length of the works, making sure that lane boundaries are clearly marked for the safety of all road users. Next week, we will be replacing the Vehicle Restraint System at the railway bridge.

In addition to the above, we have also started drainage works, which involve the installation of a new manhole chamber and the clearance of a ditch in the Westbound verge of the carriageway. Once complete, this work will make sure there is safe drainage in the area.

All of the above works will contribute to road safety. The renewed LED lighting, white lines and re-surfaced carriageway on the A52 between Gamston and Wheatcroft, will make journeys safer for road users night and day.

Please note that all our planned roadworks may be subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

All businesses remain open as usual in the surrounding areas while we carry out this essential maintenance.

I apologise for any disruption our works may cause. Please plan ahead and allow extra time for your journey.
