NOTIFICATION OF ESSENTIAL DRAINAGE WORKS A52 GRANTHAM ROAD

I am writing to let you know that we will be carrying out essential drainage work to sections of Grantham Road, Radcliffe-on-Trent alongside the A52. The works are located on the A52 eastbound carriageway from the Bingham Road junction, for approximately 300m.

Our works involve:

- replacing the existing kerbs with a combined kerb and drainage system
- clearing and re-grading existing ditches
- resurfacing and re-aligning the footway
- installing dish channel drainage blocks to the driveways on the highway boundary

Once complete, our work will mitigate future carriageway flooding and improve road safety.

When will the work take place?

Work is due to start at the **end of January 2020** and is scheduled for completion by the end of **March 2020**.

To keep our programme for these works as short as possible and to minimise traffic disruption to the local community, residents, business and road users, we will work:

- between 8pm and 6am, Monday to Friday (week night closures)
- between 8pm and 8am on Saturdays
- between 8pm and 9am on Sundays

Please note that all our planned works are subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

How will the work affect traffic?

To maintain a safe environment for our workforce and customers, we will use a mixture of three-way temporary traffic lights and full road closures along sections of the A52. All carriageways will remain open as usual outside our working hours.

During full road closures we will put in place signed diversion routes which have been agreed with the Local Authority.

How will the work affect businesses and residents?

To keep noise disturbance to a minimum, we will:

- complete as much of the of the noisy operations in the daytime
- use noise screening during our overnight works
- complete our noisiest work before midnight

We will make sure that access to businesses and residences is maintained wherever possible.

The footpath (shared by pedestrians and cyclists) and some side roads will be closed during our overnight works and we will put in place local diversion routes via alternative side roads. Access will also be provided where required, via traffic marshals.

We apologise for any inconvenience caused and will do our very best to complete the work as quickly as possible, keeping disturbances and noise to a minimum.
