1. Notice Boards: Triple Notice boards to be disposed of as old/rotten and hinders opening up of frontage) from the corner of grounds and:



a) new event notice
boards sited in
middle of village,
Walkers yard.

c) new metal framed
poster holder in
Grange Grounds

Estimate £2,500







<u>2. Additional seating:</u> in Grange grounds near play park and perimeter fencing.

Bench cost Estimate £750. To be placed adjacent the barbecue. One donated picnic bench is also pledged. To be placed adjacent play area.

<u>**3. Levelling of ground and hard standing**</u> Removal of a SMALL section of wall to the corner facing the mini roundabout.



This is proving controversial in the village and has been rejected by the Full Council, the following had been agreed:

The path from the small gate into the grounds is extremely steep, the adjacent ground requires levelling.

To take away slope and make good the area to the wall, to level and put down grasscrete. This will allow standing vehicles or a market viable. *Estimate.* £6,750



4.Gazebo: to site a covered community meeting place, ie large gazebo with planters, seating and electric hookup.

The wooden structure would be placed in the centre of the Grange Grounds to the front of the Grange Hall.

The existing 3 tier planter will be re sited elsewhere within Grounds P.C to action.



The ground will require levelling and a paved base and access path to be laid. This will be DDA access compliant, access to electricity is already in situ, but would require further cabling and hook up

The gazebo will have seating around the interior of the structure.

X4 Planters to be placed around the structure.

Estimate £15,000

Additional Improvements within Overall Scheme



1. Pollarding of trees to the front and rear of Grange Grounds.

Removal of diseased tree adjacent wall of Grounds. *Quotation sought and approved, will be carried out in January.* £900-00 via P.C Funds





<u>**2. Hornbeam whips**</u> to create hedge along Vicarage Lane boundary. Supplied via RBC January 2021.

Additional Aspiration (funding to be identified)



1. Aspiration to create a small patio and patio doors to the rear of Grange hall abutting the Trent Room . This will enhance the commercial viability of the hall.

To dig out existing bank 12.4 yds x 4yds to path level, erect retaining wall in timber/ sleepers and pave floor. Install patio doors.

Estimate £,20,000 We are aware that this part of the project

does not form part of the Growth Board proposals, <u>we chose to include this as</u> **potentially** the spoil from the digging out can be re-used in the levelling path way.
