



**"We can confirm that our works are to be completed overnight closing the A52 between Gamston and Wheatcroft roundabouts, which includes closing the A52 junctions at Tollerton Lane and Ambleside.**

**"Consideration of local residents and the classification of local roads are taken into account when assessing suitable diversion routes. As such the main signed diversion route, as sent to all transport companies, industrial areas and motoring organisations, will be via the A606 to A46 back to the A52 and vice versa. We have also informed local and national bus companies of our overnight works and have not been advised of any alterations to bus services.**

**"The diversion route for high sided vehicles will be via the A606 to A60 to A6520 Radcliffe Road to the A6011 and vice versa.**

**"As the access to Ambleside and Tollerton Lane from the A52 will have to be closed during our working hours, alternative routes have been highlighted using the attached drawing P04. Signs will be placed (as before) to advise that it is for local traffic purposes only, this will not be a signed diversion route. Therefore, heavy goods vehicles and other road users not wishing to gain access to the local community will be advised to follow the main diversion routes. All diversion routes have been agreed with Local Authority where local networks roads are used for diversions.**

**"Our Traffic Management plans are the same as which were deployed last year when we completed the main works, and is what we will be used this time for the remedial works over 4 weeks starting 11<sup>th</sup> January 2021. The safety of our workforce, the local community and road users is our number one priority. Therefore, throughout the scheme, our traffic management experts will be on hand to ensure local roads do not become congested and will revise any traffic management strategy that is deemed unsafe if necessary.**

**"We do not normally add details for the diversions with the advanced letters due to the amount of information to be provided, which can sometimes exceed the limit to be sent by email and there is also potential for paper wastage if sent out via post, but as stated in the letters, this information is available upon request.**
