

We are aware that these works will cause some disruption and delays and apologise for any inconvenience caused. To keep disruption to a minimum we will investigate ways to ease the impact of the works, including:

- We will work to minimise the number of trips through the junction for the duration of the work, by advertising alternative routes, using the A46 and A606, for traffic into and out of Nottingham.
- We will monitor traffic flows through the works and make changes to the sequencing of the temporary traffic lights wherever possible, e.g. keeping the lights on green for longer during peak times into and out of Nottingham.
- We will ensure that facilities are maintained for pedestrians and cyclists, with clearly signed pedestrian routes in place wherever needed.
- We will contact all relevant transport providers, such as bus companies, to ensure that they can plan their services around the disruption.
- We will complete the work as quickly as possible.

We are carrying these works out during the day in order to complete the work as quickly and safely as possible; if we were to carry out these works overnight they would take far longer to complete, having greater impacts on the local community and road users, which we felt would not have been acceptable.

Please note that the precise dates and times of the works may be subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances. Where possible, we'll keep you updated of significant changes and updated on the progress of the works. You can also sign up for updates on the project's webpage.

Update on the proposed left-turn bans

We wrote to you on 18 January 2021 to inform you of the proposed changes at the Bingham Road junction and the proposed removal of the left turn from Carter Avenue to the A52 westbound carriageway towards Nottingham, and the left turn from the A52 eastbound carriageway into Bingham Road.

The consideration of objections to the proposed changes is still ongoing and is following an independent process which will decide whether to implement these changes.
