Carriageway Resurfacing

Via East Midlands Ltd, in partnership with Nottinghamshire County Council, intend to carry out carriageway resurfacing on Shelford Road, Radcliffe-On-Trent, between Rushcliffe Avenue and Clumber Drive.

The work will be carried out in two phases using **temporary road closures** on Shelford Road and on adjacent side roads at the junction with Shelford Road. **The carriageway will also have a prohibition on stopping order in place to prevent vehicles parking on sections of the highway for the duration of the works.** There will be pedestrian access on existing footways available at all times. This is to comply with current Health & Safety legislation to protect the public and our own workforce.

Programmed working periods are evening / night time from 8.00pm to 6.00am.

The programmed **start date is Monday 18**th **July 2022** with works planned for completion on Sunday 31st July 2022. The programmed dates, location and main work activity are given below as a guide, which can be affected by weather conditions and material deliveries. Please note, other minor works that are not listed such as minor civils, prepatatory and survey works will be carried out within the closure areas.

Phase 1 - from Rushcliffe Avenue to South side of The Radcliffe PH

Night 1 - 8.00pm Monday 18th July to 6.00am Tuesday 19th July 2022 Removal of top 40mm of carriageway surface.

Night 2 – 8.00pm Tuesday 19th July to 6.00am Wednesday 20th July 2022 Removal of a further 60mm depth of carriageway material and laying new material in the area to be strengthened between Rushcliffe Avenue and Chestnut Grove.

Night 3 – 8.00pm Wednesday 20th July to 6.00am Thursday 21st July 2022 Removal of a further 60mm depth of carriageway material and laying new material in the area to be strengthened between Rushcliffe Avenue and Chestnut Grove.

Night 4 – 8.00pm Thursday 21st July to 6.00am Friday 22nd July 2022 Lay new carriageway surface.

Night 5 – 8.00pm Friday 22nd July to 6.00am Saturday 23rd July 2022 Lay new carriageway surface.

Night 6 – 8.00pm Saturday 23rd July to 6.00am Sunday 24th July 2022 Complete laying of new carriageway surface and lay road markings.

Night 7 – 8.00pm Sunday 24th July to 6.00am Monday 25th July 2022 No works are intended to be carried out.

Phase 2 - South side of The Radcliffe PH to north side of Clumber Drive

Night 8 – 8.00pm Monday 25th July to 6.00am Tuesday 26th July 2022 Removal of top 40mm of carriageway surface.

Night 9 – 8.00pm Tuesday 26th July to 6.00am Wednesday 27th July 2022 Removal of a further 60mm depth of carriageway material and laying new material in areas to be strengthened between south side of The Radcliffe PH and Wakefield Avenue.

Night 10 – 8.00pm Wednesday 27th July to 6.00am Thursday 28th July 2022 Removal of a further 60mm depth of carriageway material and laying new material in area to be strengthened near the Westcliffe Care Home. Start laying new carriageway surface.

Night 11 - 8.00pm Thursday 28th July to 6.00am Friday 29th July 2022 Lay new carriageway surface.

Night 12 – 8.00pm Friday 29th July to 6.00am Saturday 30th July 2022 Lay new carriageway surface and road markings.

Night 13 – 8.00pm Saturday 30th July to 6.00am Sunday 31st July 2022 Complete laying of new carriageway surface and road markings.

Traffic Marshalls will be in the vicinity of the junctions and the works area throughout the working periods to give advice on access / egress for residents. Please take care during these works and observe all signs and instructions from site personnel. **Due to the nature of the works vehicle access to properties will be unavailable at certain periods**.

A certain amount of minor noise may be generated with this operation such as engine noise of equipment and pneumatic excavation, where possible we endeavour to keep this to a minimum and before midnight, please note at the end of the operation of laying the new road surface material the workforce will be onsite to prevent vehicles damaging freshly laid materials. Construction work may continue beyond these hours in isolated cases.
