13. Parish Councillors and Outside Organisations Reports

Cllr McLeod told the meeting that the conservation volunteers have been using the mower at Dewberry Hill and have dug for 113 trees. There are 50 remaining to be done

Cllr James told the meeting that they have met with the British Legion representative and will be arranging a proper discussion regarding Remembrance in the near future

Cllr Douglas-Kirk told the meeting that Cllr Moroney has taken over as chair of the events working group. They requested more CCTV signage in Grange grounds

Cllr Thomas told the meeting that the Station group await information from the Department of Transport regarding rail services, once this is received they will arrange a meeting

Cllr Bere reminded the meeting that CPR training event is on Saturday 20th November, also that the local first responders are available to support events with first aid if requested, Cllr Bere will give the contact to Deputy Clerk

Cllr Graham told the meeting that it was the International Day of Tolerance

Chair asked Cllrs to visit the park homes area in the village as there are some unexpected changes and residents are concerned

14. Reports from Borough and County Councillors RBC and NCC Cllr Upton told the meeting that the park homes area issues are in the hands of the courts. There is a proposal at RBC to make all ClL allocation 20% whether the parish has a Neighbourhood Plan on not, this is due to 'Levelling up'. Radcliffe Health centre is high on the list for improvement

The resurfacing of The Green and Glebe Lane has been completed, the 20 marking will be added with the other road painting in the village. There is hopefully going to be better traffic signs etc at Nottingham Road and Water Lane, including bend and giveaway.
