There are still issues with the Skatepark that need addressing. Radfest had security all night and this highlighted that cars are coming and going a lot, the last skateboarders did not leave until 3am and the security light is on until 5.20am.

12. Parish Councillors and outside organisations reports

Cllr Thomas spoke on behalf of the Train Group to recognise the significant help and support they've had from the offices of Rushcliffe Borough Council and Cllr Upton who provided a lot of information to the Department for Transport for the business case for improving the rail service in Radcliffe on Trent.

13. Reports from Borough and County Councillors

- Cllr Brennan attended the J9 Domestic Violence Event that was run at The Grange a few weeks ago by Ruth Edwards MP. This is a campaign to raise awareness and encourage local businesses and organisations to demonstrate that they are a welcome place for people to go if they are victims of domestic violence to make a phone call or ask for help. It was reasonably well attended and Cllr Brennan has invited the woman who addressed

the meeting to come to a Town & Parish Forum meeting to extend the message further across the borough.

- There is a new dog waste bin on Hudson Way on the opposite side of the road so people don't have to cross the road to use a bin. Cllr Brennan has now organised 5 dog waste bins in Radcliffe on Trent.
- Cllr Brennan attended another meeting with Ruth Edwards MP regarding support of Ukrainian refugees across the Borough and how they can be helped to integrate into local communities.
- The Shelford Road resurfacing roadworks start in a few weeks. It will be disruptive for a while especially with all the other works going on but it will be worth doing.
- Approval has been given for new signage at the bottom of New Road to point to the Bingham Road shops.
- There will be a road closure during the Carnival & Parade on Saturday 8th July 2022.
- There is a Town and Parish Forum Meeting on 8th July 2022 at 9.30 at Rushcliffe Arena. Cllr Clegg plans to attend and all are welcome.
