



## **Radcliffe on Trent Parish Council January Update.**

We have met with our police liaison officer Paul Sanders who updated us on issues relating to Radcliffe on Trent. Radcliffe suffers from some anti social behaviour and minor crimes but on the whole we do not have a high rate of crime. This is not to underestimate the impact crime has on individuals, can I please ask you to report any incident that you either witness or has a direct impact on yourself. The Police are concerned about the increase in the use of privately owned electric scooters, it is clear that residents also share these concerns. To be clear it is illegal to ride an electric scooter on the highway, they may only be ridden on private land.

The Council have been involved in the setting up of The Warm Spaces project. This is a worthwhile project that provides not only a warm space but friendship and relief from loneliness. Craig Moray has been particularly well attended, and all are welcome.

March 22nd will see the Annual Parish Meeting in the Grange Hall at 7pm this is your meeting and we look forward to seeing you. Council will report on the past year's activities. We welcome questions on the night or you can send them beforehand into the office, they will be read out on the night and an answer will be given.

There will be information stalls from local organisations and community groups that are there to help and enrich Radcliffe life.

There will be local elections for the Parish and Borough Councils in May. The Parish will be holding an information evening for any one interested in becoming a Parish Councillor, date and time to be confirmed.
